



Student/Parent Agreement

Although athletics is an after-school activity, students are expected to behave on the field, sidelines, or on the bus, as they would in any other school activity. They are expected to change as quickly as possible into their game or practice clothes and gather all unused clothing/shoes into their sports bag. Please mark all personal articles or clothing with your student's name. Coaches are not responsible for school uniforms or athletic clothing left by the student. If your child brings a snack, he or she will have time to eat it before each practice or game.

Games

- **Soccer Season:** All home soccer games are played on the Daisy Lane soccer field. During the season if students are playing in the later scheduled game, they are expected to work on homework or to watch the first game. If they cannot do this in a positive way, they will be checked into Extended Day. If students are caught wandering around the school at anytime and are not with their team, they will be checked into Extended Day and will not be able to play in the game. Extended Day charges will apply.
- **Basketball Season:** All home basketball games are played at the City of Bowie Gymnasium, 4100 Northview Drive, Bowie, MD 20716. If students are scheduled in the later games, they are expected to sit in the bleachers and either watch the early game or do homework. Students will not be allowed to play on the other courts or to be disruptive in the gym. Parents are encouraged to pick up their students at the gym; otherwise they can meet the bus back at the school.
- **Football Season:** All home football games are played on the Daisy Lane or auxiliary field. Students will be checked into Extended day after a game if they have not been picked up by a parent. Extended Day charges will apply.

Coaches understand that students have other activities during the week; however coaches do expect all students to be at all practices and games. If there is a conflict on certain days, please bring this up to the coach prior to the start of the season. Together we can decide what will work out best for everyone. If you know your student will miss a game or practice due to a prior commitment or appointment, please inform the coach by email at least three days before the game or practice. If your child does not show up for a game or practice and the coach was not informed, the coach has the right to have your child sit out the next game.

Team uniforms will be distributed to all players once teams are formed. Students are expected to treat their uniform responsibly and to return it washed and in the same condition as they received it. Any lost or damaged uniforms will incur a replacement fee. Soccer teams are required to all have matching socks. Team socks will be available for purchase for \$7 a pair.

All sports schedules and away game directions can be found on the school's website at www.htrinity.org. This schedule will be updated regularly with changes, cancellations or rainouts. Please look on the school's website before calling the front office for any changes or weather concerns.
